Dr. Joseph Shepherd had put a brochure for Bond D on the tables. The Bond issue comes up every 2 years. A series of bonds in the past are being paid up, so these bonds would replace them. This is the way to fund capital improvements. Examples of the past uses was for the Museum and Light Hall to replace lots of gas lines. These bonds would go to Harlan Hall, the Science Center. Also economic development is increased because construction companies hire workers who spend money in town.

In the future, Echols Hall will be torn down with potentially a new recreation center to replace it.
