Brags and/or Happy Dollars

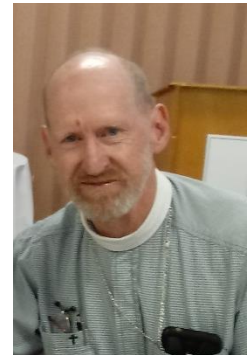
William Knuffinen took his father to Tucson and they went to a play - it was great and funny.

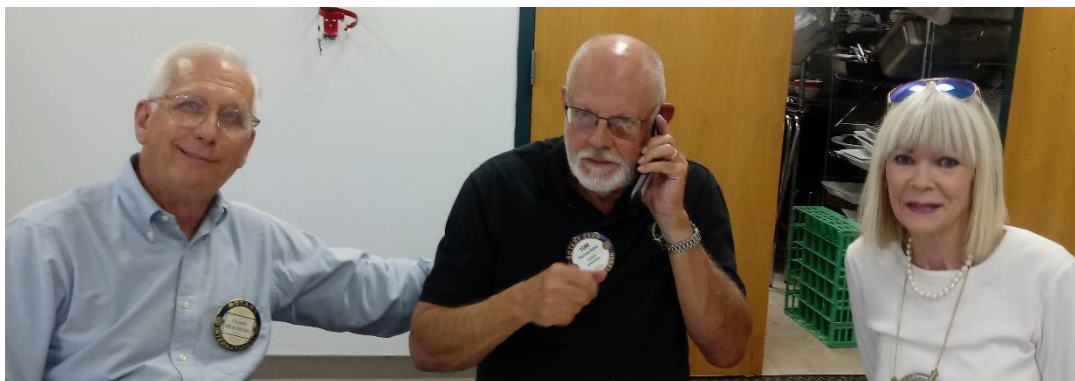
